CORRECTIONS

The staff of the Kent County Correctional Facility is dedicated to the safety and security of the community. Our corrections officers complete a 6-week field training program and a 160-hour corrections academy. There are approximately 220 sworn deputies assigned to the main facility and transfer crew/court security. The command staff includes 2 captains, 6 lieutenants, and 19 sergeants.



CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

The Kent County Correctional Facility employs podular and dormitory housing designs to accommodate over 1,400 inmates of all security classifications. Every arrestee taken into custody by law enforcement agencies in Kent County is lodged at the Correctional Facility. Corrections staff work 12-hour shifts with every other weekend off. Deputies can get sponsored and paid to attend an MCOLES police academy. We offer a lateral pay incentive for up to 60 months of credit to individuals with corrections experience.

Court Security and Transfer Crew:

Provide security at the courthouse, transport inmates to and from court appearances and scheduled medical appointments

Correctional Engagement Response Team (CERT):

Specialized in self-defense tactics, cell extractions, high-risk transports, and riot control utilizing special equipment and firearms

Utility Services Team (UST):

Firearms-trained officers utilized for emergency transports, hospital security, and perimeter security

Jail Classification:

Interview inmates and classify them based on charges, criminal history, and in-custody history to determine the best housing options and cell assignments

Jail Intelligence Unit (JIU):

Investigate serious incidents inside the facility and coordinate with outside agencies on gang intelligence

K-9 Unit:

Fully certified, dual-purpose utilized for narcotics and patrol

Field Training Officer:

Responsible for training new officers on a 1-to-1 ratio
