Employer submits signed attestation that they qualify for the DEI category |
| Geographically- Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (GDBE) | The requirements for Geographically-Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (GDBE) are detailed in. Executive Directive 2019 - 08 An indication that the GDBE satisfies one or more of the following: The GDBE is certified as a <u>HUBZone Small Business Concern</u> by the United States Small Business Administration. The GDBE principal place of business is located within a population census tract that is a low-income community designated as a <u>Qualified Opportunity Zone</u> by the United States Secretary of the Treasury pursuant to 26 USC 1400Z-1. A majority of the employees of the GDBE either work at a location within a Qualified Opportunity Zone or maintain a principal residence within a Qualified Opportunity Zone. Employer submits signed attestation that they qualify for the DEI category |
